Extension Activities:

All the extension activities are made by the college mainly in association of National Service Scheme (NSS), NCC, Eco Club, Environment & Climate Cell of Tinsukia College. Under the banner of these people our college is actively involved in a good number of extension activities besides doing its regular programs. In recognition, our College has awarded “**Best College Eco Club**” of the state for the appreciable achievement in the field of environmental education and awareness for the year 2022 by Assam Science Technology & Environment Council under Science Technology and Climate change Department, Govt. of Assam. Further, the NSS unit in association with the teaching departments of the college organizes special camps and some other need-based programmes from time to time. Following are the programmes organized during 2022-23.

G20 SUMMIT:

On 27th of January 2023 a day long workshop on the theme The Role of G20 Nations in Achieving Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) was organized by NSS unit Tinsukia College in collaboration with NCC unit of the College. The program was inaugurated by Narsing Pawar, Deputy Commissioner Tinsukia District and was assisted by Sushanta Dutta Additional Deputy Commissioner Tinsukia District. The resource person for the program was Dr. Kamallesh Kalita, Principal, Doomdooma College. Dr. Surjya Chutia, Principal, Tinsukia College delivered the welcome speech. This program was also organized as a response to the call of GOI to mark the auspicious occasion of hosting of G20 summit 2023 in India under India's presidency. The program was attended by teachers as well as students from various colleges of Tinsukia district. Invited guests and other dignitaries also attended the program.

YOUTH FOR NATION (Y4N), TINSUKIA CHAPTER:

The NSS unit Tinsukia College along with NCC unit of the college and in collaboration with Forum Y4N, an association of a group of veteran IAS, IPS, Academicians and Entrepreneurs organised the launching event of “Youth for Nation(Y4N), Tinsukia Chapter” at Tinsukia College premises on 27th of February 2023. Sanjoy Kishan, honorable minister of Tea Tribes Welfare and Labour Welfare, Govt. of Assam graced the occasion as chief guest. BLOOD DONATION CAMP:

The NSS unit Tinsukia College in association with NCC unit of the college and in collaboration with Marwari Yuva Monch, Tinsukia organised a day long Blood Donation Camp at Tinsukia College premises on 28th of April 2023. Dr. Surya Chutia, Principal Tinsukia College has officially inaugurated the Camp. The Camp was conducted with the technical support and guidance of Blood Bank, Tinsukia Civil Hospital. A total of 25 students mostly NSS volunteers have donated blood and helped the Camp to end successfully.

DISTRICT LEVEL YUVA UTSAV AND CELEBRATION OF NSS DAY:

The NSS Unit of Tinsukia College with collaboration of Nehru Yuva Kendra, Tinsukia under the banner of (Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports ,Government of India) organised and actively participated in the District Level Yuva Utsav and celebrated NSS day, contributing the larger framework of India @2047. The event took place on 24th September 2022, bringing together students, volunteers and community members in a collective effort towards community service and societal betterment.

The NSS Day celebration commenced with an inaugural ceremony with a lighting a lamp by the Principal , Tinsukia College in front of Swami Vivekananda , highlighting the significance of National Service Scheme and its role in fostering social responsibility among the

youth. Dignitaries from the district administration, college faculty and notable personalities graced the occasion. Emphasis was placed on aligning these initiatives with the broader goals of sustainable development and community development.
