Part B

Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the Institution.

Our organisational mission and goal is to impart value based education coupled with necessary skill and competencies to enable students to face the challenges of the ever changing world. As such, besides regular theoretical and practical classes; a good number of other programmes are organized to help students to realize their potentialities and become an active agent in the process of nation building. The college administration is sensitive to the needs of the society and tries its level best to introduce new courses and academic activities to enrich the experiences of students. The college administration is well aware of the special needs of the under privileged sections of the society including the scheduled castes and scheduled Tribes, OBC and minorities. Every year, a good number of students are given financial aid out of poor students Fund. Some important activities organised by the different teaching departments and other wings of the college during the academic session 2006-2007 are as follows:

- 1) In order to provide best infrastructural facilities, the Governing Body of the college decided to have a separate building for newly launched three years BBA programme. As such the foundation stone of the aforesaid block was laid down on 8th July 2006 by the G.B President Mr. Sujit Roy which is likely to be funded partly out of UGC fund and partly out of college development fund. The building was expected to be ready within a period of six months so that classes could be shifted to the new building from 1st January 2007.
- 2) Swami Isatmananda Maharaj of Ram Krishna Mission was invited on 1st September 2006 to deliver the foundation Day lecture on the topic "Role of discipline in the academic life of the students" to inculcate the values of sincerity, dedication and discipline in the pursuit of self development and career progression.

- 3) Prof. Aparna Mahanta, HOD of English, Dibrugarh University was invited to deliver an expert lecture on the topic 'Emergence of Gender Studies' to sensitize the faculties and students to various gender issues inflicting our society and their adverse impact on the socio economic condition prevailing in the society.
- 4) Prof. Nagen Saikia, a noted writer, former professor of Assamese at Dibrugarh University and former President of Assam Sahitya Sabha delivered a lecture on "Socio cultural Transformation" on 11th November 2006 and highlighted the various aspect of Sociocultural changes that are taking place worldwide in general and in Assamese society in particular.
- 5) A district level one day Workshop on Recitation was held in the college premises on 27th December 2006. The workshop was organized by literary and debating wing of the Students' Union in collaboration with the Asomiya Sahitya Sora. Mrs. Juliana Begum and Mr. Jitumoni Saikia acted as resource persons. A group of students from Digboi Mahila Mahavidyalaya also took part in the workshop. At the end of the workshop, certificates were given to the participants by the Principal Dr. Bhuban Gogoi.
- 6) The Internal Quality Assurance Cell of the college oganised a Career Awareness programme on the theme "Hospitality Tourism and Civil aviation" on 7th November 2006, Mr. Ratindra Sen from Guwahati appraised the students about career prospects in Hospitality Management. About 200 students joined the programme.
- 7) A book written by Mr. Ranjan Kumar Das, Senior Lecturer, Department of Geography titled "Pakhir kakalit Dibru Saikhowa" was released by Mr. Harendra Nath Borthakur on 8th November 2006. The book contains a detailed description of various kinds of birds which are found in Dibru Saikhowa National Wild Life Sanctuary.
- 8) A group of 20 students from Geography Department under the guidance of Mr. H. L. Verma, Senior Grade Lecturer visited Calcutta University on 26/10/2006 as part of their field study programme.
- 9) On 9th December, 2006, a group of 16 students from Zoology Department visited "Namdapha National Park" under the guidance of Dr. Rishi Das, HoD, Zoology as part of their field study programme.
- 10) The Women's study and Development cell of the college organised a counseling programme on 17th February, 2007 on the topic "Stress Management during Exams" for the inmates of the Girls' Hostel. About 89 inmates took part actively in the counseling programme. Dr. Deepanjali Borkotoky, a renowned Psychiatrist acted as the resource person.
- 11) The Women's Study and Development Cell also organised an awareness programme on 8th March 2007 on 'Domestic Violence Act' at the Kachujan Village.
- 12) A Text book written by Dr. Bhuban Gogoi, Principal, Tinsukia Collge, titled 'Prakritik Bhugol' was released on 4th January,2007.On the same day, Dr. Bhuban Gogoi, Principal, Tinsukia College, also inaugurated the 4th edition of the departmental Wall magazine of geography department 'Brahmaputra'. A Departmental Seminar on "Renewable Energy

- Resources in India with special reference to Wind Energy" was also organised on the same day. Dr. Kamaleshwar Kalita, Lecturer, Dept. of Geography, Tinsukia College presented a paper on the topic..
- 13) An Analytical essay volume on Jyoti Sangeet "Jyoti Sangeet : O Mor Sapon Seuji" written by Dr. Bhuban Gogoi, Principal, Tinsukia College was officially released by Harendra Nath Borthakur on 17th Feb.,2007. The inaugural meeting was presided over by Amulya Khatoniar, a renowned reporter and cultural activist of the district.
- 14) The Newly constructed "Centre for Management Education" block of Tinsukia College was formally inaugurated by Rajendra Prasad Singh, MLA Tinsukia Assembly Constituency on 15th February, 2007. On this occasion, Students of BBA programme demonstrated their activities and outstanding performances during the last two years through a Power Point Presentation. The local MLA Mr. Rajendra Prasad Singh also announced a grant of Rupees Five lac for the development of the college.

New Academic Programme Initiated

The department of Zoology Planned a six months certificate course in Bioinformatics in collaboration with DOEACC Centre Guwahati. Necessary proposal was sent to the Governing Body of the college and affiliating University for necessary approval. The course is likely to be started from the Academic Session 2007-08.

Innovation in curriculum design and Transaction

The college, being an affiliated institution, does not have much liberty with regards to curriculum design and development. The Under Graduate Board of the affiliating University frames the syllabi and the curricula. The college being affiliated to the University has to follow it in its entirety. However, several teachers of the college are members of the under graduate Board of Dibrugarh University. They, in association with other members of the Undergraduate Board, design the syllabi for different Under Graduate Courses.
