Department of Bengali observed "International Poetry Day"

Tinsukia College, 22nd March, 2023: On the occasion of "International Poetry Day" renowned Bengali poet and author Amitabha Deb Choudhury was invited to Tinsukia College on 21st March 2023 by Department of Bengali, Tinsukia College to deliver a talk on 'Bengali Poetry of North East India'. Students and teachers of the department overnight organized the event and made it a grand success. Almost 60+ present and ex-students of the Department were present. Dr Sushanta Kar, HoD, Bengali Department presided over the event. At the very beginning, he introduced the poet and his literary works with the students. Anamika Nag Sarkar, Assistant Professor of the Department honoured him with 'Phulam Gamocha'. After that Amitabha Deb Choudhury presented his talk and told that writings in Bengali have an old history in North East India. Even in pre-British India Bengali literature has a great heritage here. Dimacha and Tripura kings not only supported the Bengali authors, some of them also practicing writer and creators. In colonial period Ananga Mohini Devi of Tripura and Ram Kumar Nandi Mazumder of Assam initiated modernize the tradition. He said Ram Kumar Nandi Mazumder wrote 'Veerangna Patrottor Kavya' immediate after publication of great Bengali collection of poem by Michael Madhusudan Dutta 'Veerangna Patra Kavya'. Also mentioned works of great poets like Amalendu Guha, Hemanga Biswas, Urdhendu Das, Debendra Paul Choudhury, Shaktipada Brahmachary and many more.

In spite of being written in Bengali, poetry of N.E India has its unique character -he traced. Geo-Social character of the region has its own differences from greater Bengal. And Bengali literature has depicted such character with full zeal and commitment. So, without going through literature of this region was cannot get a complete picture of Bengali Language and literature. Ms. Mampi Acharjee recited one poem of Jay Goswami. Deep Roy, ex student of the department also read one of his own writing. Ms. Shelly Dutta, Assistant Professor, recited her own poems and delivered vote of thanks to all.


