Observation of Foundation Day

2nd September, Tinsukia College: The 67th Foundation Day of Tinsukia College was observed on 1st September with a day-long programme. The celebration was started with campus cleanliness drive by the Eco Club and NSS volunteers. Mr. Dilip Kalita, President of Governing Body (GB), lighted the Foundation lamp followed by hoisting of College flag and presentation of college anthem by the students. The programme is followed by floral tribute to the statues of Rupkonwar Jyotiprasad Agarwala, Kalaguru Bishnu Parasad Rabha and Sudhakantha Dr. Bhupen Hazarika by Ms. Monika Devi, (HoD, Chemistry), Dr. Ratna Gopal Gogoi (HoD, Hindi), and Mr. Ajit Ch. Phukan (HoD, Economics) respectively. There after payed homage to martyrs of Assam movements by Dr. Ranjan Kr. Das (Vice Principle) along with other teachers and students. Invited chief guest, Shri Sanjoy Kishan, Minister for Labour & Tea Tribes Welfare, Govt. of Assam inaugurated the newly constructed building under RUSA 2.0 scheme in the presence of teachers, past and present and students of the College. The open session started at around 11 am with the felicitation to the invited guests. Kishan (Hon'ble Minister) in his speech assured to provide financial support to the College. The programme was followed by song presentation by Ms Tulika Das, Assistant Professor, Department of Assamese. Invited speaker Mr. Luit Das, who is a noted AIR artist delivered a lecture on folk culture and tradition. He also released two research books namely Prapancha: A Collection of Research Based Articles on Arts and Commerce edited by Dr. Mayuri Sharma Baruah and Dr. Ratna Gopal Gogoi and Horizon: A Collection of Research Based Articles on Multi-Disciplinary Science edited by Dr. Satyajyoti Gogoi. The programme was followed by distribution of awards and prizes to the best graduate from the three streams (Arts, Science and Commerce) of the College. instituted this year. This year Mr. Manjil Madhur Neog from Botany and Ms Neha Deb from Zoology were the recipient of this award. Both were awarded with a certificate and cheque of Rs. 30000 to each. The programme ended with vote of thanks by Dr. Biplab Banik, Assistant Coordinator, IQAC.
