Action Taken Report (2020 -2021)

The following remedial measures are undertaken as a follow-up action in response to the Students' Feedback for the academic session (2020-21)

- A state-of-the-art computer laboratory has been constructed at the library building that can accommodate 50 students at a time. Presently 35 computers are procured for the benefit of the students. Another 15 computers will be procured later. Students can access these within the college hours.
- Internet facility is provided to the students in general. However, poor connectivity being a genuine issue pertaining to this particular region affects the service provided.

The following remedial measures are undertaken as a follow-up action in response to the Students' Feedback for the academic session (2019-20)

- The sick-room, carpeted with polyvinyl coating, is innovated with the inclusion of a new bed and emergency first-aid facilities.
- Two sweepers have been newly appointed to wash and sanitize the students' toilets regularly on daily basis. Further, the college authority has decided to materialize the proposed plan to construct a new toilet facility for girls.
- Students' common rooms are ameliorated with inclusion of more furniture, wall fitted looking glass and better condition bathroom and toilet.
- The 15-stationed multi-gym has been overhauled and an order has been placed for a new Olympic Set.
