

REPORT ON AWARENESS ON SEXUAL HARASSMENT/WOMEN TRAFFICKING

On 22nd August 2016, an Awareness Programme was held in Tinsukia College Girls' Hostel wherein Ms. Anjana Goswami, Ms. Monika Das and Ms. Mayuri Sharma Baruah, members of Hostel Committee spoke on various issues related to sexual abuse and women safety for generating awareness among the boarders.

Towards the end of 2016, GSCASH in collaboration with CWSD (Cell for Women Studies and Development) of Tinsukia College organised an awareness campaign on Sexual Harassment. Consequently, six schools (two of them were co-ed schools) and one Junior College were selected within Tinsukia District for this campaign.

As part of this campaign, Ms Mayuri Sharma Baruah and Ms Roshmi Dutta delivered lectures on sexual harassment and its consequences at Sarvajanan Uchatar Madhyamik Valika Vidyalaya on 12th September 2016. All total 97 students participated in this deliberation. During the interaction session several students shared their personal experiences on sexual abuse. Principal Rina Kumari Khanikar actively participated in this programme. Dr. Deepika Bhattacharjee, member, CWSD, also participated in the interaction session.





The next programme was held on 4th November 2016 at Bengali Girls' Higher Secondary School, Tinsukia. As resource person, Dr. Deepika Bhattacharjee delivered her speech about the implications of sexual harassment and how to fight against this. Total 200 students were present in this programme. In the interaction session students came out with their personal experiences. Ms. Mayuri Sharma Baruah, Ms. Sangita Baruah, Ms. Rasmita Borkotoky, Ms. Hima Hazarika Das and Ms. Roshmi Dutta interacted with the students.



On 8th November 2016 Ms. Indira Baruah and Dr. Ruby Baruah made deliberations on sexual harassment and duties of teachers in the awareness programme held at Nalini Kanta Dohutia Junior College, Tinsukia. A total number of 79 students were present in this programme. Principal Dr. Rishi Das and Vice Principal Monoj Gogoi appreciated the effort of CWSD, Tinsukia College in creating awareness on a relevant issue like sexual harassment. Ms. Anjana Goswami and Ms. Monika Das interacted with the students.





The venue for the second programme held on the same date (8th November 2016) was GBC School, Makum. There Ms. Rasmita Borkotoky and Ms. Tulika Das delivered lectures on sexual harassment and the responsibility of society in eradicating such problem. Total 185 students from class 5 to 12 took part in this programme. Ms. Mayuri Sharma Baruah and Ms. Roshmi Dutta also interacted with the students. Principal Ms. Nilakshi Dutta expressed her concern on the increase of harassment cases and termed it as a serious problem of our society.



Then on 9th November 2016, Ms. Monika Das and Ms. Hima Hazarika Das delivered their thought provoking lectures on sexual harassment and also came out with some measures in the awareness campaign held at Adarsha Valika Vidyalaya, Parbatia. 169 students participated in this programme. Head Mistress in-charge Ms. Bipasha Handique spoke on the importance of such awareness programmes at school level. Dr. Bandana Pujari, Ms. Momi Shyam and Ms. Roshmi Dutta were present in this programme.





On 15th November 2016, Ms. Anjana Goswami and Ms. Monika Devi spoke elaborately on sexual harassment and the role of society in eliminating such evils in the programme organised at Jatiya Vidyalaya, Barekuri. Including students of Jatiya Vidyalaya, Barekuri and girl students from Barekuri Ucha Madhyamik Vidyalaya, a total of 136 students attended this programme. Dr. Bhairab Borgohain, Ms. Sangita Baruah, Dr. Ruby Baruah, Ms. Mayuri Sharma Baruah, Ms. Hima Hazarika Das and Ms. Roshmi Dutta were also present in this programme.









On 14th February 2017, a signature campaign was launched by CWSD in support of Subhalaxmi, a college going student from Jorhat who was sexually abused on the street. By expressing solidarity with Subhalaxmi, CWSD members displayed posters in the campus highlighting her case and her courage in fighting back for justice. The posters carried slogans like “We respect men who respect women”, “Subhalaxmir atmamaryadar samarthanat” etc.



On 8th March 2017, an awareness programme on sexual harassment was organized specially for the boarders of the college girls' hostel. Dr. Hima Das Hazarika was the resource person for the programme. Besides, a movie titled 'Bawander' was shown to the audience.




As part of International Women's Day celebration, CWSD of Tinsukia College organized a programme on sexual harassment wherein Dr. Roshmi Dutta, Ms. Rasmita Borkotoky and Dr. Hima Das Hazarika spoke in details on the topic. Some videos were also shown to the audience present. About hundred participants including students and faculty members attended the thought proving session.



On 8th March 2019, Juri Bora Borgohain, a noted Assamese novelist was invited by CWSD as the resource person for a seminar on “Women trafficking in North-East India” organized by it. Her deliberation was an eye opener for the gathering. The programme was graced by 154 persons including 17 faculty members.



On 29th November 2021, CWSD organized a memorial meeting on the occasion of ‘Dr. Indira Goswami’s death anniversary. An awareness campaign on “Gender Inequality: Facts and Fiction” was also held as part of the meeting. Ms. Mayuri Sharma Baruah was the resource person who pointed out how men and women are victimized in the name of gender inequality. She urged the students present in the meeting to raise their voices as and when they come across any kind of gender disparity. 96 students along with 16 faculty members attended the programme.
