
A brief summary of the Workshop

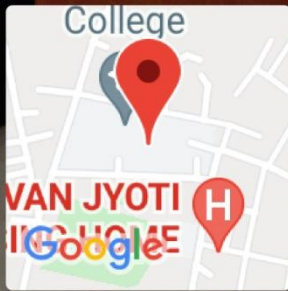
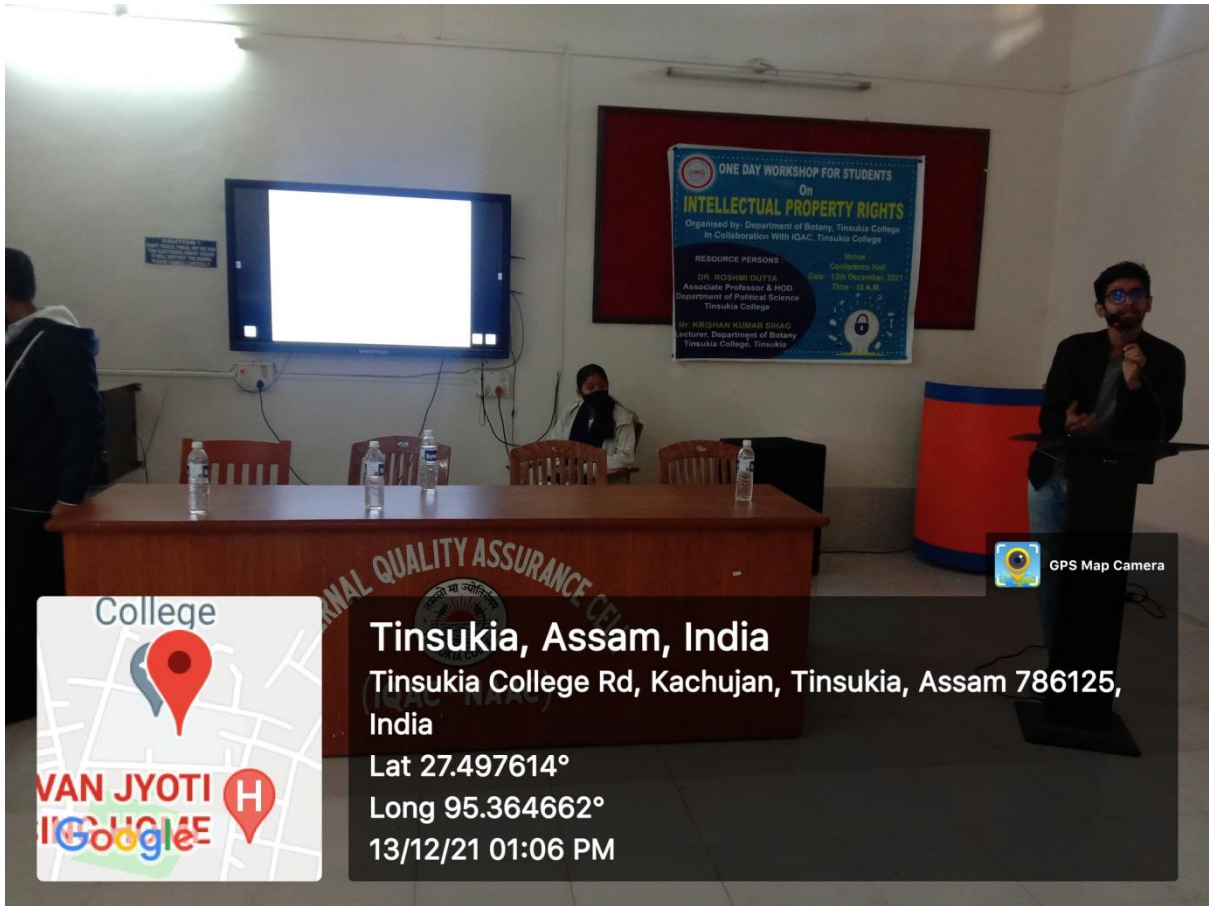

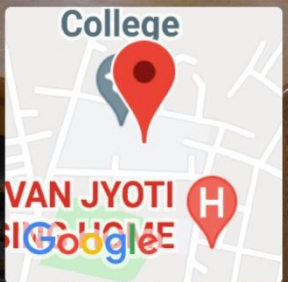
