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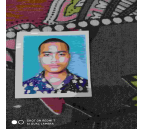

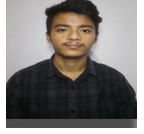

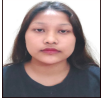

Instructions for the Candidates

01. The examination will commence on the date according to the Programme previously notified.
02. The Doors Of the Examination Hall will be opened on the morning of the first day , one hour before and in the afternoon and on the others Days, 15 minutes earlier than the time appointed for this commencement of the examination. The Doors will be closed on each day 5 minutes before the commencement of the examination after which no candidate will be admitted without the special permission of the Officer-in-Charge . In no case a candidate shall be admitted or given a question paper more than 15 minutes after the examination has commenced.
03. Candidates must take their seat at least 15 minutes before the time appointed for the commencement of the examination.
04. No Candidate shall be allowed to leave the Examination Hall until an hour has elapsed from the time when the papers are given out.
